4. Restoration of relationships within local churches and unity between churches: divisions, pride, jealousy, etc.

5. Pray that the Church will be a fearless and clear Scriptural prophetic voice to accompany and correct the government when and where necessary.

1. Pray for professional behaviour, enthusiasm and good role modeling by staff.

3. Pray for all learners / students - that those who are Christian will stand strong for what is right; for those who do not know the Lord to come to a place where they will encounter Him; for those in gangs to realize they are damaging themselves and society; for the victims and perpetrators of violence and abuse.
4. Leaders responsible for improving and maintaining good academic and moral standards.
5. Healthy lifestyle of students.

7 Seek His face by praying the *Word* (5 min)

Start to pray systematically through the Psalms. Read and pray through 2-3 Psalms every time you pray.

8 Seek His face through *watching and listening* (5 min)

Ask the Lord to reveal new things to you, things that He wants you to notice and pay attention to. Ask God to reveal his will and strategies/plans to you. Ask the Lord for things that are on his heart that He wants you to pray about. Write down (journal) what you sense God is saying to you.

9 Seek His face for breakthroughs and His intervention in the following challenges in NM Bay (5 min)

1. The HIV/AIDS pandemic and immorality, sexual perversion, prostitution.
2. Pray against any prejudice especially in the areas of racism and sexism.
3. Pray against crime and violence in NM Bay.
4. Pray that arts and media in our city will glorify God.
5. Ask forgiveness for witchcraft, idolatry, bloodshed, immorality and broken covenants.
